Re-location of Oil Pressure Sensor onto Rear Face of Engine.

- 1. The oil pressure sender is fitted to the upper starboard front face of the engine via an aluminium right angle adaptor (T67A-50-525).
- Two cases have occurred of cracking of the adaptor, due to overtightening.
- Mod 58 has been introduced to relocate the oil pressure sender to the rear of the engine, using a new adaptor (T67A-50-561) which is not susceptible to damage by overtightening.
- 4. Mod 58 is not mandatory.
- 5. Owners who wish to incorporate Mod 58 should apply to the undersigned, in which case a kit, with all necessary materials and instructions, will be supplied free of charge; owners should make their own arrangements to have the Modification fitted.
